SUMMERIN ATIKOKAN

CHARLESON RECREATION AREA

 If you're a fan of extreme sports like motocross, own horses, or want a spot to camp, this is your area, located in town.

MOTOCROSS TRACK

 The Atikokan Motocross area has been used by dirt bikes on and off since the early 70s.
We boast a safe and exciting track for all skill levels and are a favourite amongst anyone that rides here.

STEEP ROCK MOUNTAIN BIKERS

 Atikokan is not just known for its canoeing, but also its extensive Mountain Biking Trails.
There are several trails throughout the Charleson Recreation Area that lead into lakes and rivers

QUETICO PARK

 It is world-renowned for its natural beauty. Known as one of the finest wilderness canoe parks with over 450,000ha of protected land. There are thousands of interconnected lakes, rivers, portages, etc., that make the experience a once-in-alifetime trip.

DAWSON TRAIL CAMPGROUND

 Visit our beautiful Quetico Park campground located on French Lake. The Chippewa and Ojibwa areas have a combined total of 106 campsites which include 49 with electricity, 3 rustic cabins, laundry facilities, showers, comfort stations, and parking facilities.
Some services are not available during the off-season. There is approximately 30 km of groomed hiking, skiing, or snowshoe trails at Dawson Trail.

LITTLE FALLS GOLF COURSE

 The nine-hole course features a picturesque view of its namesake waterfalls from Hole 7 and has views of the Atikokan River throughout the course.

FISHING

ATIKOKAN IS HOME TO HUNDREDS OF LAKES IN OUR BACKYARD!

Each lake is unique in its way. Many lakes are easy to access from town, remote fly-ins, portage lakes, ponds, rivers, etc. The fish in Atikokan range from Walleye, Bass, Perch, Lake Trout, and Northern Pike all being the most common. You're sure to have a nice day on the lake when it comes to fishing in Atikokan. The summer days are warm and fish are biting. It's an experience that you'll have to try for yourself!

ICE FISHING

Much like the summer, the lakes and the fish are the same but it's a very different experience. Hopping on a snowmobile, starting a campfire, and waiting for the fish to bite is one of the most calming, yet exhilarating experiences. There are hundreds of unique spots to try and Atikokan in the winter has some of the most picturesque nature in Canada.



ATIKOKAN BASS CLASSIC

Date: August 18th-19th

MINIER IN ATIKOKAN

MOUNT FAIRWEATHER

 Downhill skiing at Mount Fairweather provides some of the best skiing on this side of the Rockies, with runs for all skill levels and easy access that puts it less than 10 minutes outside of Atikokan. We have 12 different runs to use.

SNOWSHOE TRAILS

 There are 2 trails located in Atikokan. The "Don Park Loop" is 3.4km, and the "Minnow Pond Loop" is 1.5km long.

PUBLIC SKATING RINKS

 There are 3 outdoor skating rinks that are free to use located at St Pats School, Lone Pine, and Don Park which are all located in town.

COMMUNITY ARENA

 The newly built arena is full of events and is inexpensive to rent.

SNOWMOBILING

With access to over 2500 km of beautiful trails in the region, the Atikokan Sno-Ho Snowmobile Club is located in the Heart of the Continent. The club offers top-level riding experiences for riders of any skill. There are kilometers of trails winding through the bush or hidden bays full of powder or lake riding. For nature seekers, you may be able to see deer, moose, lynx, bald eagles, or other wildlife along the trails. The low population density allows you to ride all day, virtually undisturbed – just you and nature on the open trails!


